Assembly

Print the pages.

Using the dotted lines as your guides, fold the card in half (horizontally). Using the dotted lines as your guides again, fold the card in half (vertically).

Writing the Thank You Notes

Students should determine who they are going to give the cards to.

Help students write thank you notes.

1. Begin with a greeting (Dear Grandma,)
2. Add a few sentences thanking the person for the gift or time spent with you.
3. End with a closing (Thanks Again,)

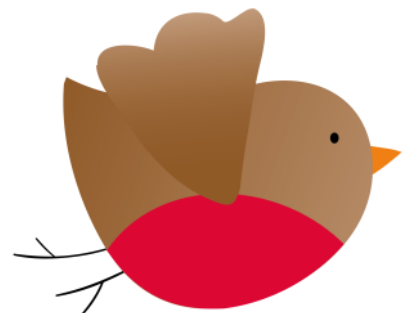
Students can use the word bank page to help with ideas and spelling.

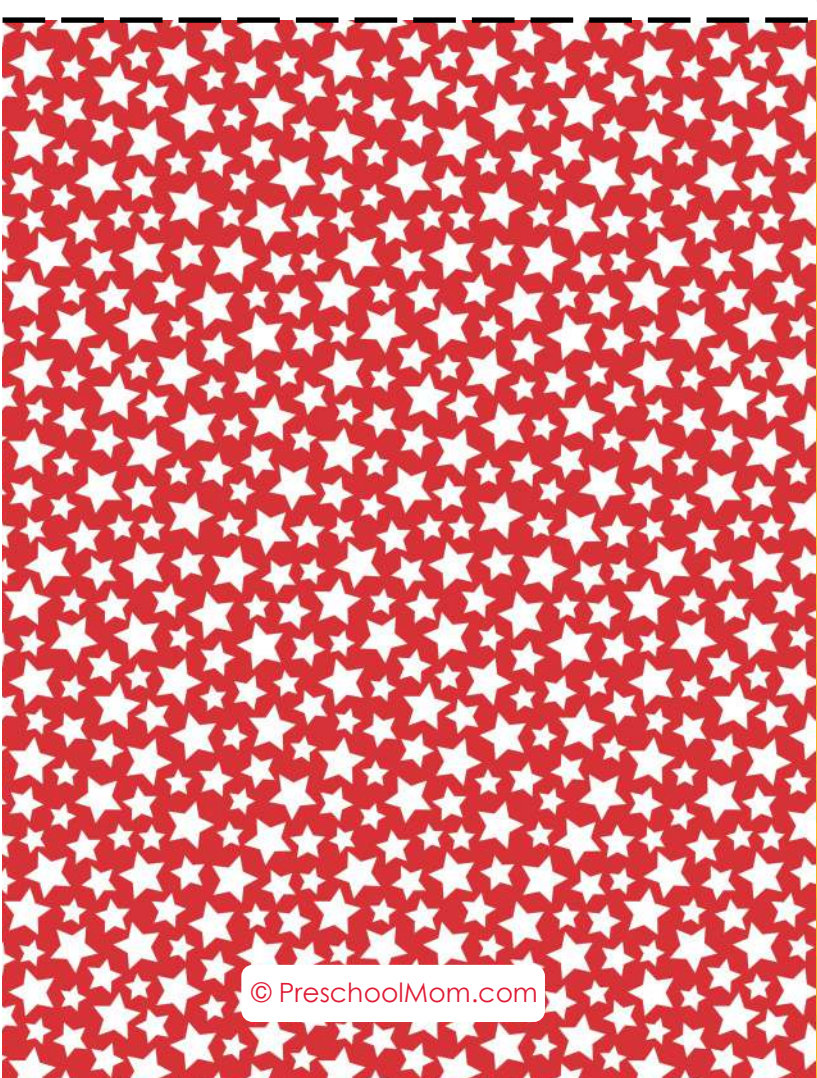

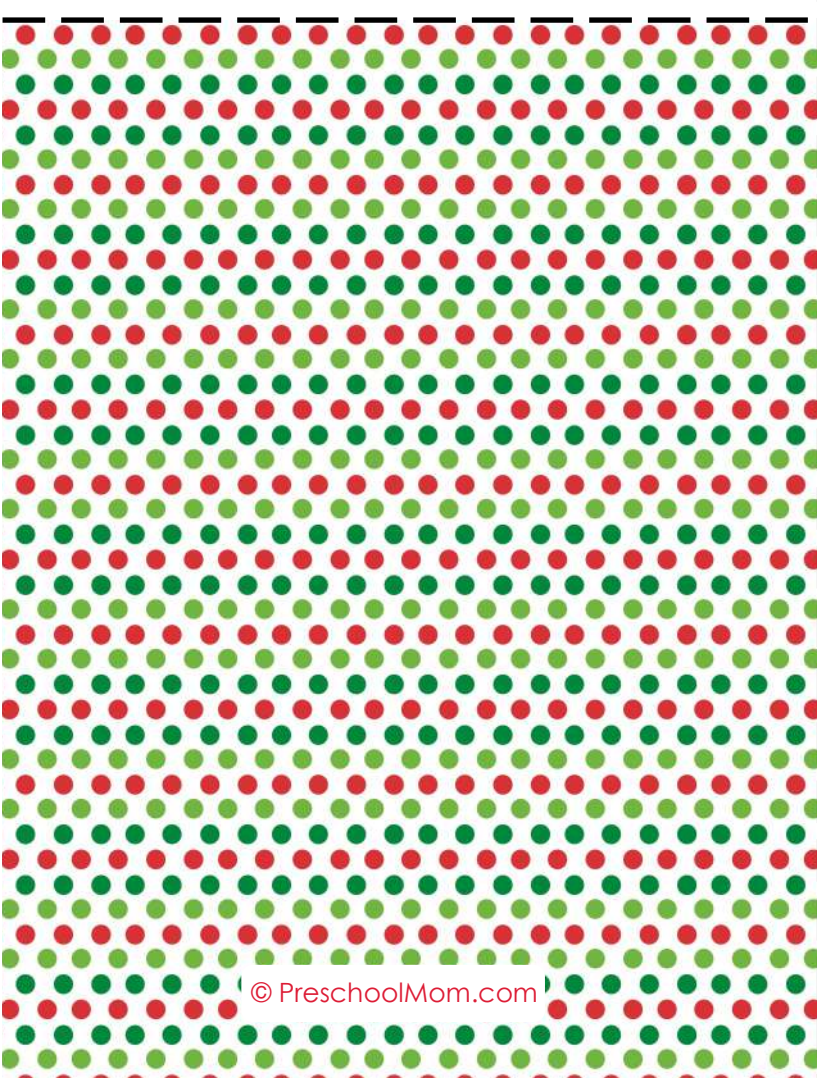

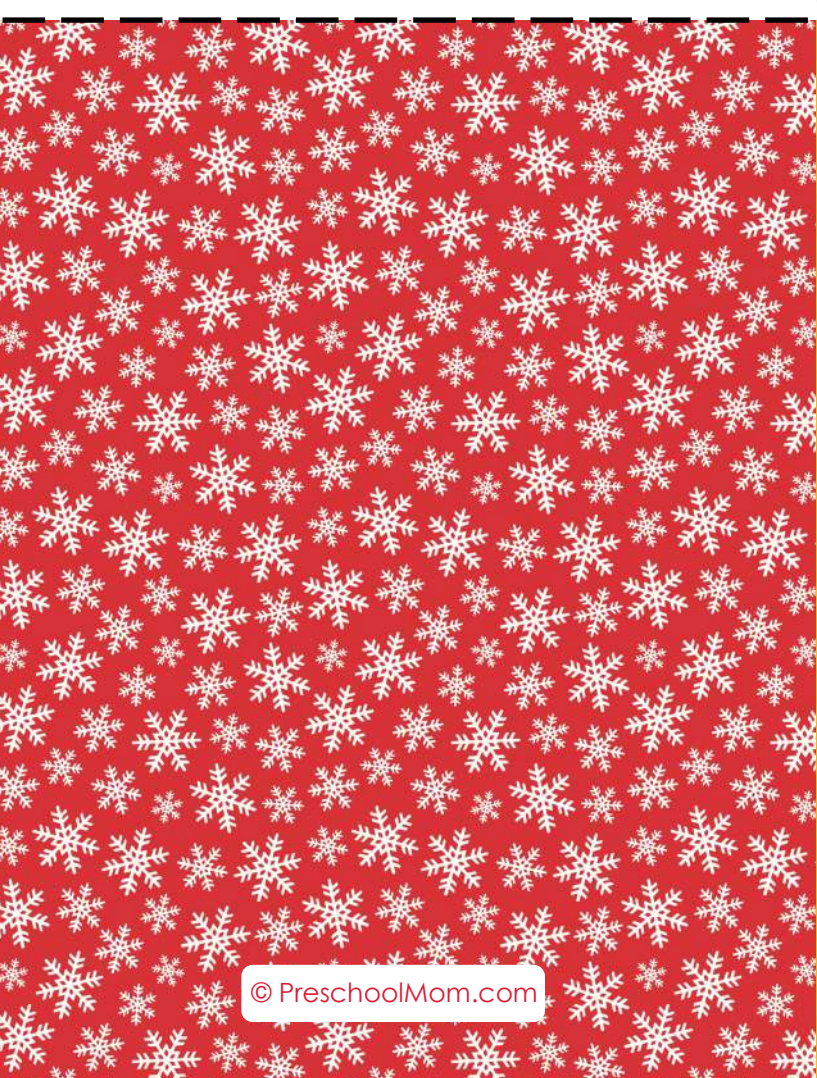
